1. Buck Session - Sunday October 20<sup>th</sup> 2pm to 5pm

A total of 13 people made it to the Buck for this first monthly session of the 2024-2025 season. Eight people performing with voice or instrument or both, our dedicated trio of Dalesbus followers from Bradford and a couple of non-combatants or potential performers another time. After establishing the pattern of alternating instrumental tunes and songs or poems there was a pause for discussion on the future of these sessions. Without the leadership and inspiration of the late lamented Bob Ellis and Muppett were these sessions viable?

#### CONCLUSION?

<u>Positive commitment and desire</u> to say we should keep going until March 2025 and review the situation at the end of the season.

Some practical suggestions made:

- Could there be use of Facebook or other social media to publicise the sessions more widely? No one present had the know-how to do this.
- Let there be a list available of a core selection of Dales and other tunes which have featured in the sessions since they started in June 2022. This would make it easier for would-be musicians to know what to expect and to come prepared. (Richard is working on something like this already.)
