
2. A GREAT NEW INITIATIVE

Workshops to take traditional Dales tunes and dances into schools and the public. Caller Peter Barnard explains:

This spring Peter Barnard and Mark Wallace will be starting a project to take the Dales dances and tunes into communities across the Dales. As well as running workshops which anyone can attend, they are going into local schools to introduce the children – and later their parents – to their local dances, and to deepen their appreciation of their heritage.

They are starting their project in Middleham on Tuesday 18th March (the primary school and The Key Centre) and in Hawes (the primary school and The

Dales Countryside Museum) the following day. They aim to build on these visits in those locations as well as broadening out further across the Dales.
